5 LANDS WALK VISUAL ARTS COMMITTEE & AVOCA ARTISTS INC Avoca Beach & Copacabana 2012

The 5 Lands Walk and theme of the exhibition

The 5 lands walk is an annual cultural event that began in 2006. It is a cultural, physical and spiritual journey comprising a 9 km walk through the 5 coastal lands of Macmasters Beach, Copacabana, Avoca Beach, North Avoca and Terrigal. It is timed to correspond with the winter solstice and the annual northern migration of the whale, which is the totem of the Darkinjung people of the Central Coast.

Along the walk each village hosts cultural activities reflective of their community with the aim of connecting people to people and people to place. These activities include the presentation of food, music, dance, land art, paintings and photography, as well as education in Aboriginal culture and heritage, whale migration and the surrounding natural environment. The event is a fusion of artistic, cultural and physical approaches to a sense of place. All the creative arts of each community contribute to the festival. The 5 Lands Walk is a combination of five events in one. People who come to experience the event can do so on one land or all five, creating their own story. The 5 Lands Walk Exhibition *Connections* is one of those cultural events and is unique to the festival. It adopts the 5 Lands Walk theme of connecting people to people and people to place.

Exhibition Information

The 5 Lands Walk Inc Visual Arts Committee and Avoca Artists Inc invite all Artists to enter the Connections exhibition. Connections will be held at the Avoca Beach Surf Club and the Copacabana Surf Club on 23 and 24 June 2012 to coincide with the 5 Lands Walk. You will be advised of the Surf Club in which your work will be exhibited, based on your residential proximity. Artists are invited to submit an entry by 18 May 2012 for selection to the Connections exhibition. No entry forms will be accepted after this date and no artwork will be accepted into the exhibition without having been through the entry form process. Artists may submit up to 2 artworks. There is a \$15.00 entry fee for each artwork, payable to Avoca Artists Inc. Numbers may be limited if we receive a large number of entries. All artwork must be delivered ready to hang. Wet artwork will not be accepted. No changes are to be made to the title, price etc once your entry has been accepted. The organisers charge no commission on sales. The organisers do not have the facility to make direct sales but sale prices and contact details will be included in the exhibition catalogue. It is the responsibility of the artist to make any sale and exchange goods. All artwork is to be delivered between 10am and 11am on Thursday 21 June 2012 if you are exhibiting at Avoca Beach and between 10am and 11am on Tuesday 19 June 2012 if you are exhibiting at Copacabana. All artwork is to be collected from the Surf Clubs Sunday 24 June 2011 between 4-5pm
